Club TalkMore is a facilitated social group for 4-7 year olds to share, play, engage and connect with each other - establishing lasting friendships because of mutual interests.

Children help set the schedule weekly from a variable set of choices. All activities require at least two people. Siblings and friends of club members are welcome to join.

These groups are especially helpful for children who struggle to make friends independently in other settings.

These weekly group sessions focus on social and play skills - expanding use of social language to build mutually satisfying friendships that transcend the group experience.



For a child to benefit from this group therapy, s/he should have:

- (1) awareness of and interest in other people
- (2) functional and symbolic communication
