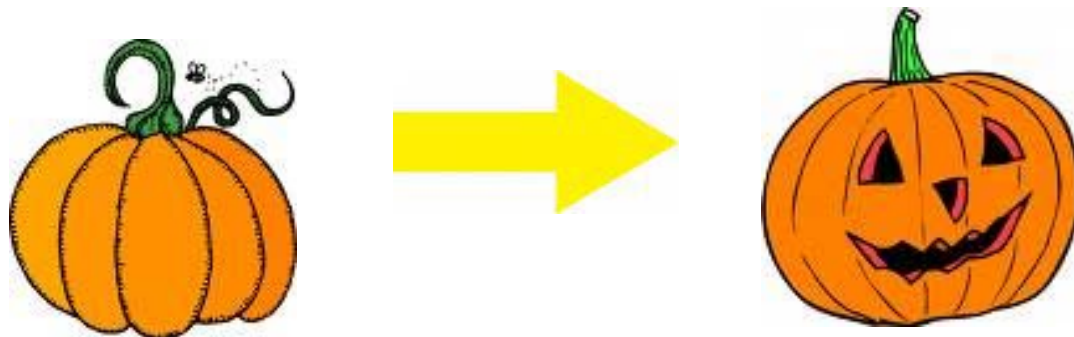
Children can go to houses and get candy.

People feel differently about Halloween.

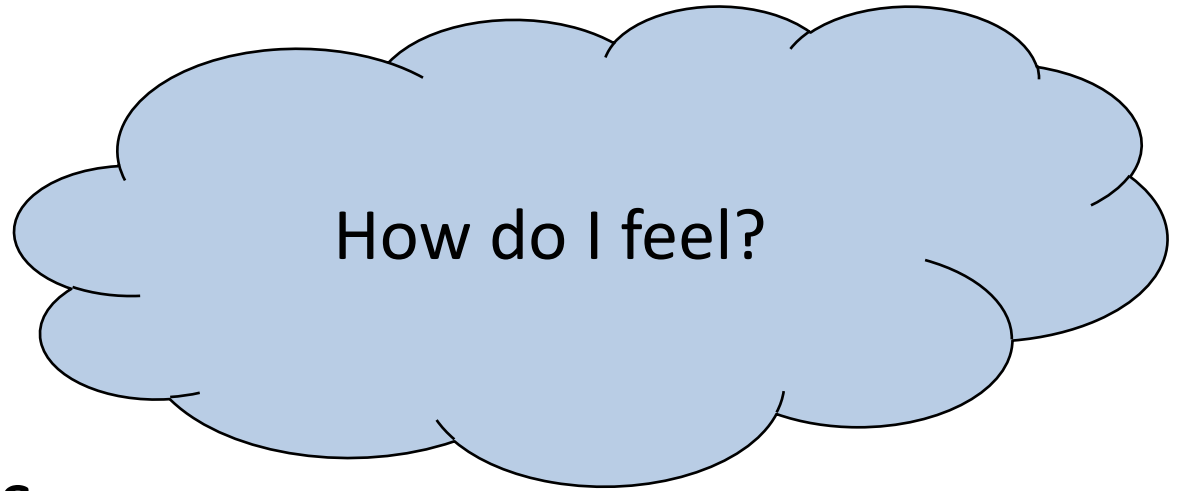
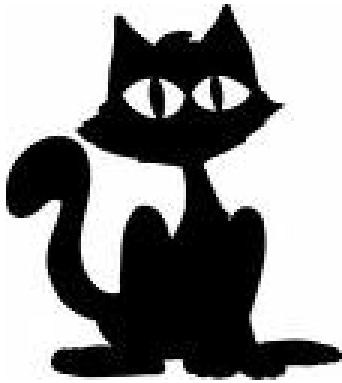

- nervous

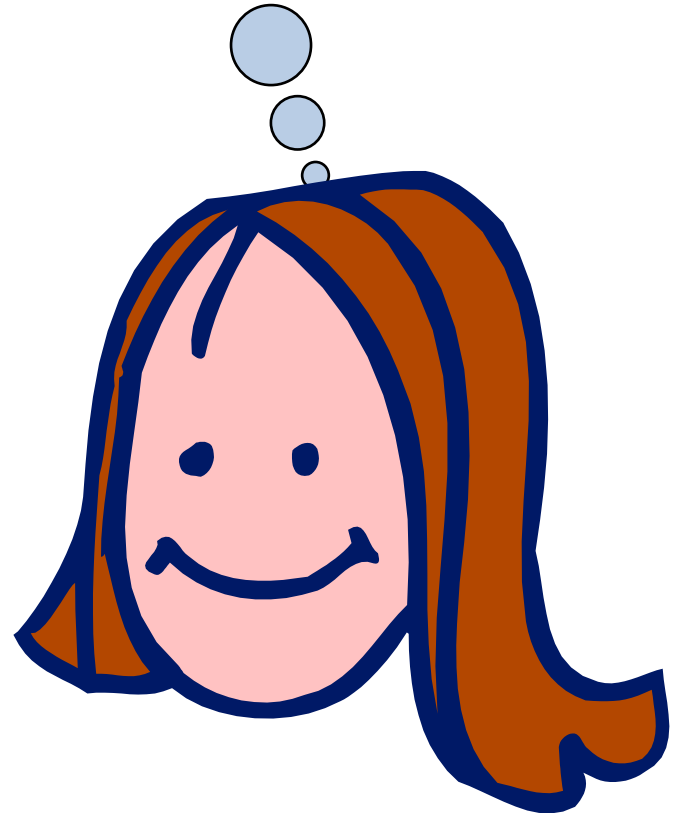

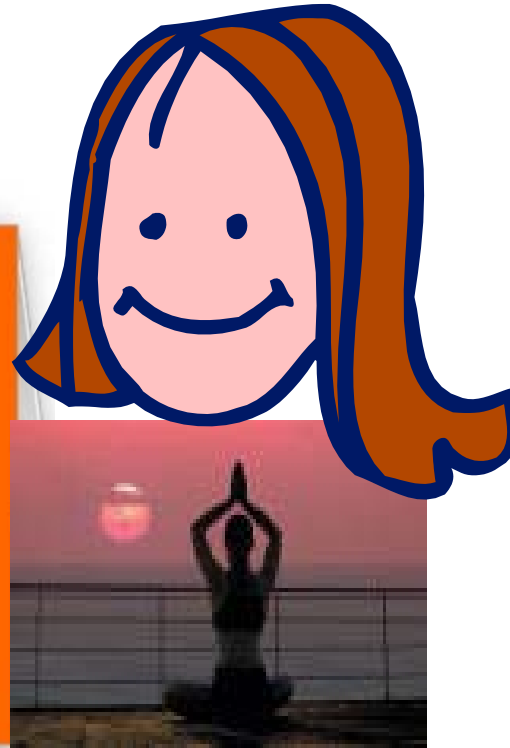
